The Atlanta Passport Agency will host a Passport Acceptance Event from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 24, 2025, with the Office of Senator Warnock at Atlantic Station 201 17th St NW Atlanta, GA 30363.

Appointments must be confirmed. There will be <u>no passports printed at the event or on the</u> <u>same day</u>. All applications will be processed in accordance with Passport Services national processing commitment times.


The U.S. passport card is not valid for international air travel. Unlike the U.S. passport book, the U.S. passport card is valid only for entry at land border crossings and sea ports of entry when traveling from Canada, Mexico, the Caribbean, and Bermuda.

All applicants must appear in person (including minors). Minors under the age of 16 must appear with both parents. If one parent is not available, a notarized DS-3053 Statement of Consent authorization from the non-appearing parent is required, along with a photocopy (front & back) of the absent parent's ID. You may locate this form on <u>travel.state.gov</u>.

Each applicant **must bring** to their appointment:

- completed DS-11 first-time or DS-82 renewal application (please read information pages),
- valid government issued driver's license or university/college student ID,

- proof of U.S. citizenship: a previously issued U.S. passport, original birth certificate, certificate of Naturalization/Citizenship, or Consular Report of Birth Abroad,
 - Photocopied certificates are <u>only</u> acceptable for renewing applicants via the DS-11.
- front and back photocopy of the ID to be presented at the time of passport acceptance,
- passport photograph, measuring 2-by-2 inches, on a white background.
 - Passport photographs can be taken at the nearest CVS, FedEx, Walgreens, etc.



U.S. passport holders who will have less than six months validity on their passports should consider renewing their passports.
