Marine Corps Logistics Base-Albany	This project would provide a new communication facility that will serve as the Installation Service Node (ISN) and Special Purpose Processing Node for Facility Related Control Systems and other future operational technology.	Albany GA	\$52,000
Marine Corps Logistics Base Albany	This project would provide for a consolidation of five dispersed work centers at MCLB-Albany to improve health and safety of the command's work force, increase production efficiency, reduce expenses, and expand vehicle and property lifespans.	Albany GA	\$559
