AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. WARNOCK (for himself and Mr. BOOZMAN) to the amendment (No. 5499) proposed by Mr. REED

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle A of title VI, add the following:

2 **SEC. 606. REVIEW OF DISLOCATION AND RELOCATION AL-**

3 **LOWANCES.**

4 Not later than one year after the date of the enact-  
5 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall submit  
6 to the congressional defense committees a report—

7 (1) reviewing the adequacy of the amounts of

8 dislocation and relocation allowances paid under sec-

1       tion 452 of title 37, United States Code, to members  
2       of the uniformed services in connection with changes  
3       in such members' temporary or permanent duty as-  
4       signment locations, taking into consideration the ris-  
5       ing costs of moving, challenges in the housing mar-  
6       ket, and other expenses incurred by such members;

7           (2) assessing the effects of delays in the  
8       issuance of orders relating to changes to temporary  
9       or permanent duty assignment locations on the tim-  
10      ing of dislocation and relocation allowances paid to  
11      members of the uniformed services;

12           (3) assessing the feasibility and advisability of  
13      paying dislocation or relocation allowances to mem-  
14      bers of the uniformed services who are permanently  
15      assigned from one unit to another with no change of  
16      permanent duty station when the units are within  
17      the same metropolitan area; and

18           (4) making recommendations with respect to  
19      the matters described in paragraphs (1), (2), and  
20      (3).
