SEC. 2. PLACEMENT OF STATUE OF SHIRLEY CHISHOLM IN UNITED STATES CAPITOL.

3 (a) OBTAINING STATUE.—Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment of this Act, the Joint Com-4 5 mittee of Congress on the Library shall enter into an agreement to obtain a statue of Shirley Chisholm, under 6 7 such terms and conditions as the Joint Committee con-8 siders appropriate consistent with applicable law. The 9 Joint Committee may authorize the Architect of the Cap-10 itol to enter into the agreement and related contracts re-11 quired under this subsection on its behalf, under such terms and conditions as the Joint Committee may require. 12

(b) PLACEMENT.—The Joint Committee of Congress
on the Library shall place the statue obtained under subsection (a) in a permanent public location in the United
States Capitol.

17 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
18 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
19 necessary to carry out this Act, and any amounts so ap20 propriated shall remain available until expended.
